



## Top B.C. Interior Logging Contractors 2010

The general downturn in the forest industry in the last few years has not only taken its toll on the mill side of the business, but also on logging contractors. Due to shutdowns, temporary closures, the mountain pine beetle epidemic, and changes to BC forest allocation policies, there has been a trend for older logging contractors to retire, and for some younger owner/operator contractors to seek employment elsewhere.

However, many of the well-established, larger logging contractors have managed to weather this difficult economic climate and are seeking every opportunity to pick up extra contracts--as they become available--to try to maintain their traditional annual harvest volumes.

It seems that the general feeling is that the worst is now behind the industry and many are looking forward to better times in 2010/2011.

New opportunities such as use of biomass in the bioenergy sector will likely also open up new business opportunities for existing contractors and new contractors wanting to strictly focus on that developing sector of the forest industry.
